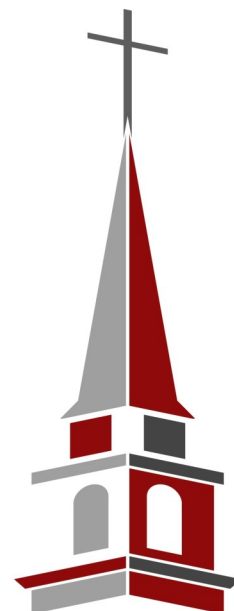

I am from the mountains And the beaches From the peninsula where my father created our home.

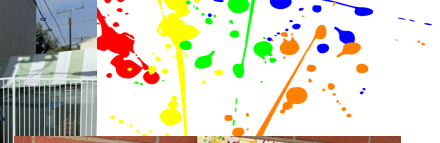
I am from peppermint Taffy and sailboat races On the ocean
